Regular cleaning Manual cleaning	At least once a week	 	Neutral detergent	After dry sweeping, damp cleaning.
Deep cleaning Mechanical cleaning	As necessary	 	Alkaline detergent pH > 9 Red disk	After dry sweeping, cleaning with the auto scrubber.

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

- **Before any cleaning operation**, thoroughly sweep or vacuum clean the entire surface in order to remove any loose material.
- Following **damp cleaning** (manual or mechanical), there should be no visual traces of water or moisture. Stagnant water trapped between tiles can be a source of unpleasant odours.

For **manual** damp cleaning, the dust mop must be damp but not soaked.

For **mechanical** damp cleaning, the disk is dampened beforehand, water flow is set to minimum and suction is set to maximum. Adjust the machine settings with the supplier.

- If a single-brush machine is used instead of an auto scrubber, it is essential that the water used is sucked up until the surface is dry and there is no water trapped between the tiles.
